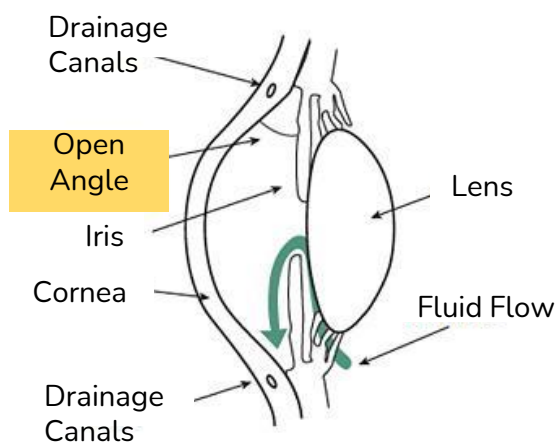


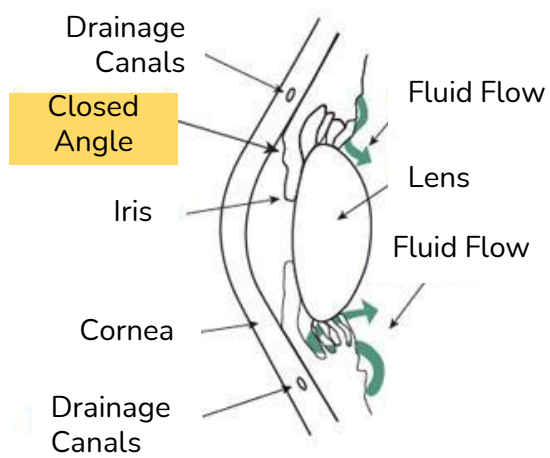
Don't Lose Sight of Glaucoma

Glaucoma is one of the most common eye diseases among Asian Americans, especially those over 60 years old. It is caused by increased pressure in the eye due to fluid buildup, which damages the optic nerve and can lead to vision loss and blindness. Two main types of glaucoma are open-angle (chronic), and closed-angle (acute).

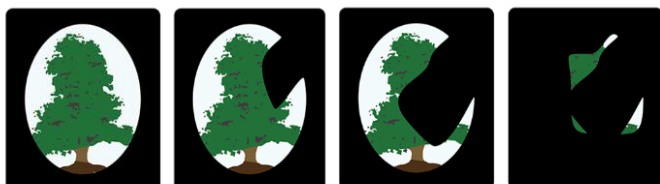
Open-Angle Glaucoma

Open-angle Glaucoma

- Caused by **slow clogging** of the drainage canals, resulting in increased eye pressure and optic nerve damage
- Develops slowly with **no obvious symptoms**

Closed-angle glaucoma

- Caused by **complete blockage** of drainage canals, resulting in **sudden vision loss** within a few days.

Symptoms

- Morning Headaches
- Red Eye
- Nausea and Vomiting
- Eye Pain
- Visual Impairment

Treatment options

- Laser Surgery
- Trabeculectomy
- Medication



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
